PLANT AND NON-DOMESTIC ANIMAL QUARANTINE
PLANT INTRASTATE RULES

INSPECTION AND CERTIFICATION REQUIRED:

- Plants and propagative plant parts, including seeds
- Non-domestic animals (mammals, birds, fishes, reptiles, amphibians, and insects)
- Green coconut leaf products including baskets, hats, etc. (Oahu to Neighbor Islands)
- Soil, animal manure and sand contaminated with soil

NO INSPECTION REQUIRED:

- Cut foliage (including cut Christmas trees), flowers, and leis (subject to periodic inspection)
- Fresh fruits and vegetables
- Domestic animals and poultry including dogs, cats, rabbits, pigeons, chickens, ducks, geese, and turkeys
- Livestock including pigs, sheep, goats, horses, and cattle (require Certificate of Ownership/Movement, Form DC-44-Animal Industry – For information call 808-483-7113)
- Produce not listed as prohibited
- Orchid seedlings in sterilized flasks

PROHIBITED:

- Any commodity infested with a pest, unless subjected to a treatment to eliminate the pest.
- Banana plants and parts except banana fruit (Oahu/North-South Kona Districts of Hawaii Island to Neighbor Islands)
- Papaya and cucurbit (melon) plants (except to Maui, Oahu, Hawaii Island; subject to inspection)
- Taro and dasheen plants (Hawaii Island, Oahu, and Lanai to un-infested islands)
- Sugarcane plants and/or parts (Except by Permit)
- Green coffee beans and coffee plants (except by permit)
- Hosts of Ohia Wilt / Rapid Ohia Death (ROD) and soil from Hawaii Island (except by permit)

BEEES AND USED BEE KEEPING EQUIPMENT

- Bees (dead or alive) and used bee keeping equipment (please contact HDOA)

AIRPORT INSPECTION (Oahu)

Please bring items to be inspected to the Plant Quarantine Airport Office on the Ewa Service Road under Gate 32. Or go to the Information Counter and call the Plant Quarantine Airport Office (Use Airport Phone) and Dial 3689. Telephone Number (808) 837-8413

INSPECTION AT THE PLANT QUARANTINE STATION (Honolulu)
